

**NOTICE OF ELECTION
AND
RESOLUTION NO. 2019-27**

WHEREAS, there currently is in effect in the City of Marietta, Oklahoma, the tax of three percent (3%) imposed on proceeds from sales and the storing, using or otherwise consuming within the municipality tangible personal property purchased or brought into the municipality; and

WHEREAS, a special election should be called to be held in the City of Marietta, on the 11th day of February, 2020, for the purpose of approving or rejecting the question of whether the tax imposed on proceeds from sales and the storing, using or otherwise consuming within the municipality tangible personal property purchased or brought into the municipality herein, shall continue for 5 years at three percent (3%), and after 5 years, the amount of sales tax shall revert to two percent (2%);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Marietta, Oklahoma, that they do hereby notify the Secretary of the Love County Election Board that they will call and give legal notice of a special municipal election to be held on the 11th day of February, 2020, for the purpose of voting upon the Proposition of whether proposed Ordinance No. 2019-09 amending Section 90-33 of Article II and Section 90-56 of Article III, of Chapter 90 of the Marietta Code of Ordinances, to continue the three percent (3%) for a period of 5 years, commencing March 3, 2020, and after 5 years the three percent (3%) will revert to two percent (2%), the total tax imposed on proceeds from sales and the storing, using or otherwise consuming within the municipality tangible personal property purchased or brought into the municipality should be approved.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the exact wording of said Proposition to be submitted to the registered voters shall be as follows:

PROPOSITION

Shall proposed Ordinance No. 2019-09 amending Section 90-33 of Article II and Section 90-56 of Article III, of Chapter 90 of the Marietta Code of Ordinances, to continue the three percent (3%) for a period of five (5) years commencing March 3, 2020, and after 5 years the tax will revert back to two percent (2%), the total tax imposed on proceeds from sales and the storing, using or otherwise consuming within the municipality tangible personal property purchased or brought into the municipality; and repealing any ordinances or code provisions, or any parts thereof, in conflict therewith, be approved?

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ballot setting out the Proposition to be submitted to the registered qualified voters shall set out the proposition as above set forth and shall also contain the following words:

FOR THE ABOVE PROPOSITIONCYES

AGAINST THE ABOVE PROPOSITIONCNO.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such election shall be held at the same place and in the same manner prescribed for the conduct of special municipal elections and that the designated polling places shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall also constitute the proclamation calling for such special election, and the City Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of said Resolution to the Secretary of the Love County Election Board after the Council's approval of the same.
