## ESTABLISHING A CRIMINAL JUSTICE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Marietta Police Department desires to establish an internship opportunity for individuals enrolled in a criminal justice degree program at an Oklahoma college or university. where said degree program requires an internship with a criminal justice agency; and

WHEREAS, the person selected for the internship will be tasked with administrative assignments and projects to further the work and efforts of the Department; and

WHEREAS, it is believed the internship program will provide great recruitment opportunity for the Department; and

WHEREAS, this resolution serves to memorialize the action of the governing body regarding the hours, duties, compensation, and benefits for the internship position described herein:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Marietta:

- 1. There is hereby established a criminal justice internship program within the Marietta Police Department.
- 2. To be eligible for the program, an individual must be enrolled in a criminal justice degree program at on Oklahoma college or university, where said degree program requires an internship with a criminal justice agency.
- 3. The program shall consist of one (1) internship position which shall not exceed four hundred fifty (450) hours-worked per calendar year.
- 4. While participating in the internship program, the individual shall be considered a temporary/part time employee pursuant to Section 207.C of the Employee Handbook of Personnel Policies.
- 5. Compensation for said individual shall be based on rate A1 of the Grade and Step Structure adopted by City Council on November 12, 2019.
