AUTHORIZING LONGEVITY BONUS FOR FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, City of Marietta seeks to give longevity bonus' for all full-time employees:
and

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta will now give longevity bonus' for full-time employees:
and

WHEREAS, the City has funds available in the in the budget due to not replacing employees.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to use those unused salary and insurance funds in the form of a longevity bonus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marietta:

1. Full-time employees shall be issued a longevity- bonus in the gross amount of \$100 per year employed.
2. Bonus will be given on the anniversary date of employment starting at year 2.
3. Bonus amount will cap at \$3000.
4. This resolution will expire on January 1, 2031, after a 5(five) year sunset clause.

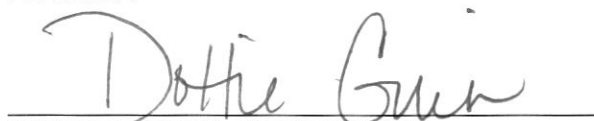
